## Enrollment growth slows in Oldham schools

Oldham County Schools experienced the smallest growth in student enrollment that the district has seen in a decade, according to school officials.

On the first day of school this year, 11,544 students were enrolled, which is 106 more students than were enrolled on the first day of school last year, said Michael Williams, the district's director of pupil personnel.

That works out to a less than 1 percent increase compared to last year, while the district has grown between 3 percent and 5 percent each year for the past 10 years, Williams said.
